## Bob Chilcott

Described by the Observer as "a contemporary hero of British choral music", Bob Chilcott has become one of the most widely performed composers in this field in the world.

Bob's large catalogue of works reflects his broad taste in musical styles and love of writing for singers. His output ranges from his much-celebrated music for young choirs to a number of larger-scale choral works including his "Requiem". In 2013 he was commissioned to write the Anthem for the 60th Anniversary of the Coronation of Queen Elizabeth II.

He is much sought after by choirs around the world and since 1997 he has guest conducted in 30 countries. For 7 years he was conductor of the choir at the Royal College of Music and has been Principal Guest Conductor of the BBC Singers since 2002.

Bernard West has been an organist for over twenty years since becoming tall enough to reach the pedals. He directs a number of local choirs and also works regularly as an accompanist for many other groups. He is very excited to be working with Bob again.
